- **Character traits**

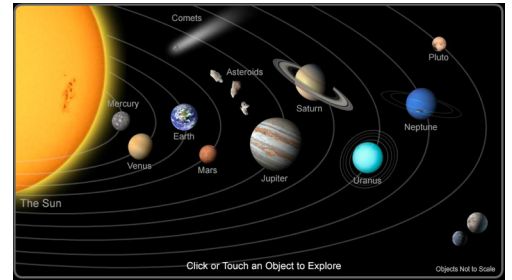
MATH
